WELCOME TO YOUR VOLUNTEER JOURNEY!

While the Formula 1 Qatar Airways Qatar Grand Prix 2025 is hosted for the fourth time in Qatar, for the first time ever, volunteers like you have the chance to be part of the event here!

We're thrilled that you're considering being a part of this exciting experience at the Lusail International Circuit! Below are some frequently asked questions to guide you through the process and prepare you for what's ahead.

We have separated your questions according to the stage you are in within your Volunteer Journey.

Following are the General Frequently Asked Questions during the Application Stage

Who can apply?

Age

You are eligible to apply if at least 18 years old by **November 1, 2025**.

Visa

If you are a **Qatari National** or a Resident with **valid QID** then you are eligible to apply.

Your QID is essential for completing your application. Without it, your registration can't be processed. Your QID expiry date must be after **December 2, 2025** to be eligible.

This time around, we're only accepting applications from those who are already living in Qatar and hold a **valid QID**. But don't worry, Qatar will host plenty more events in the future, and your chance to get involved is coming!

Availability

You must be available for **mandatory training session in November** and all **three event days**: November 28, 29, and 30.

Language

Conversational English is required for all volunteers. Since English is the primary language of communication at the event, it's important to have conversational skills to ensure a smooth experience for both you and the team.

We welcome applicants from all backgrounds. Be sure to mention any special requirements in your application so we can accommodate your needs.

When does registration open, and what's the deadline?

Registration kicks off on 12th October 2025. While the last date of applications is 25th October 2025, we highly recommend completing your application as soon as possible.





Please note, the deadline date is tentative as once we reach the maximum capacity for volunteer applications we will close the registration. Spots fill up quickly, so don't wait!

How do I register?

If you meet the criteria, you can apply via the Lusail International Circuit Volunteer Programme Portal. The process should take around 15 minutes if you have your **QID** and **profile picture** ready.

Photo requirements:

- Clear, focused on your face and eyes, with a plain background.
- Must be a .jpg or .png, under 500KB.
- Neutral expression, facing the camera directly.

What's the timeline for becoming a volunteer?

Here's a quick breakdown of the process:

- October 12: Register and complete your application.
- Early November: Role offers sent to selected candidates.
- **Mid and End November**: Training Sessions! Your assigned dates and times will be shared with you by email. Uniforms and accreditation will be distributed in November as well depending on if you attended the training session.
- November 28, 29, and 30: Volunteer at the Formula 1 Qatar Airways
 Qatar Grand Prix 2025.

How will I know if I'm selected?

Some volunteers will receive an acceptance email by **early November**. Some volunteers may be placed on a waitlist. All applicants will be notified by **mid-November**.

Will applying guarantee that I can volunteer?

We wish we could say yes to everyone, but due to the high number of applications and limited positions, not all applicants will be selected. If you're successful, you'll receive an email with all the details.

Can I choose my volunteer role?

Engagement is key! While you won't be able to pick your exact role, you will be able to select the 2 functions you are most interested to volunteer with.

What happens if I can't attend one of the event days?

Unfortunately, attendance at **training session** and all **three event days** is mandatory. Missing any of these will result in being withdrawn from the Programme.

Will I get paid for volunteering?

No monetary compensation is offered, but the rewards are endless! You'll develop new skills, build your professional network, and gain invaluable experience at a world-class event. Plus, the memories and friendships you'll make are priceless.

Will I receive a uniform?

Yes! Every volunteer will be provided with a uniform and an accreditation to wear during the event. Distribution will take place before operations start—stay tuned for details.

Will transportation be provided?

We're working closely with the transportation department to ensure a smooth transportation experience for all volunteers. More information will be shared soon.

Will meals be provided during shifts?

Absolutely! A meal will be provided for each shift you work. Your meal break will be decided by the FA lead and you will be sent for your meal in waves.

How long will my volunteer shifts be?

Shift lengths depend on your role but expect them to be **between 6 to 12 hours** with a meal break in between.

How many shifts do I need to commit to?

You'll need to commit to:

- Mandatory training session in November.
- Three event days on November 28, 29 and 30.

Will I receive a certificate for my participation?

Yes! All volunteers who have completed all three event days will receive a certificate in recognition of their valuable contribution to the Formula 1 Qatar Airways Qatar Grand Prix 2025.

Can I volunteer for other events while participating in this one?

While we admire your enthusiasm for volunteering, we ask that you ensure full commitment to the Lusail International Circuit Volunteer Programme. Your priority should be fulfilling all the required shifts and duties for the **Formula 1 Qatar Airways Qatar Grand Prix 2025.**

What happens if my QID is invalid or expires during the process?

Your QID must be valid throughout the entire volunteer process. If your QID expires or is invalid, it could affect your eligibility to continue in the programme. The expiry date of your QID must be after December 2, 2025. If there's an issue, please contact us

What are the volunteer roles that I can choose from?

As a volunteer, you'll be involved in a variety of roles, and each role is designed to ensure the event runs smoothly. Your responsibilities will depend on your assigned task and the project/department that you are in. These will be described in detail to you during our training sessions and by your project lead. Here are the Roles you might be interested in while applying.

Spectator Services

Guide and assist fans in the grandstands to ensure a smooth experience.

Fan Zone

Assist fans with activities and directions in the Fan Zone area.

Fan Zone (Kids Area)

Assist children and families with activities and guidance in the kids' zone.

Mobility Assistance

Provide support to fans requiring wheelchairs or golf buggy transport.

Information Point

Assist fans by providing directions, guidance, and event information.

Workforce

Support and assist fellow volunteers throughout their shifts.

Ticketing

Assist with queue management and fan support at ticket checkpoints.

Sustainability

Support sustainability initiatives by checking and guiding proper practices.

Catering

Help with distributing water at designated tents.

Hospitality

Assist with queue management and guest support in hospitality areas.

Medical

Assist the medical team in supporting fans and participants in need of care.

Media

Assist the media team with press, broadcast, and content support.

Transport

Assist with wayfinding and guidance in parking and bus areas.
